We, too, can find our Golden Fleece through intelligence, . . . courage and determination—the same qualities which helped past Argonauts win theirs.

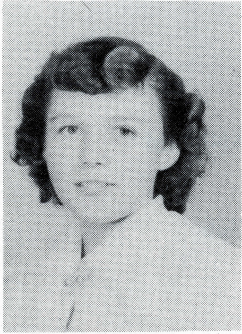
